

## Ashton Hayes Governors Pecuniary Interests Register

2019/20

The school is required to compile a Register of Pecuniary Interests for staff and Governors. Governors are asked to declare any interest they, or a close relative, may have with any local firms from which the school may wish to buy goods and services. Common examples are self employed contractors such as builders or electricians.

A pecuniary interest is any form of remuneration. The school is not forbidden to trade but the interest should be declared.

Annually, Governors must state whether:

*Neither I nor my close family have any financial interest in any company/organisation from which the school may wish to purchase goods or services.*

Or

*I or a member of my family have a direct/indirect link with the following companies/bodies/organisations.*
