

<b>Magnetic letters</b>	Use magnetic letters to spell words. You could stick them on the fridge, a tin lid or a tray. You can also use them to make words before writing them down.
<b>Magazine letters</b>	Why not find letters in magazines and newspapers to make your spelling words? Cut them out and use them to make the words.
<b>Sound colours</b>	Use a different colour for each sound in the word. look pig pull
<b>Word collection</b>	Hunt for words in magazines, newspapers, leaflets etc. and make a collection of them.
<b>Chalk words</b>	Use giant chalk outside on the ground or on a wall to write your words. You could make rainbow words or play word hopscotch!
